



Rev. Sydney Morris

The Keweenaw Unitarian Universalist Fellowship recently celebrated the awarding of the degree of Doctor of Ministry from Meadville Lombard Theological School, Chicago, to their minister, the Rev. Dr. Sydney A. Morris. Rev. Morris also has a Masters of Divinity from Harvard University. She served congregations in Iowa and Vancouver British Columbia before coming to the Keweenaw Fellowship in 2002.

An adult religious education curriculum entitled "Values-Based Financial Practices" on the topic of sustainable and responsible financial practices was the subject of her dissertation. She helped found a socially responsible mutual fund company where she continues to serve as chair of the Governance Committee of the Board. Rev. Morris also served as chairperson of the Unitarian Universalist Association's Committee on Socially Responsible Investing.
